



HARDWARE WARRANTY AND SOFTWARE LICENSE

PLEASE READ THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THE SOFTWARE. BY USING THIS SOFTWARE YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS LICENSE. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH THE TERMS OF THIS LICENSE, PROMPTLY RETURN THE UNUSED SOFTWARE, MANUAL, AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AND HARDWARE (WITH PROOF OF PAYMENT) TO THE PLACE OF PURCHASE FOR A FULL REFUND.

ImageStream Internet Solutions, Inc. (“ImageStream”) and its suppliers grant to Customer (“You”, “Your” or “Customer”) a nonexclusive license to use the ImageStream software (“Software”) in object code form with equipment supplied by ImageStream or its authorized distributors and resellers. Customer may make one (1) archival copy of the software provided Customer affixes to such copy all copyright, confidentiality, and proprietary notices that appear on the original. EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED ABOVE, CUSTOMER SHALL NOT: COPY, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, SOFTWARE OR DOCUMENTATION; MODIFY THE SOFTWARE; REVERSE COMPILE OR REVERSE ASSEMBLE ALL OR ANY PORTION OF THE SOFTWARE; OR RENT, LEASE, DISTRIBUTE, SELL, OR CREATE DERIVATIVE WORKS OF THE SOFTWARE.

Customer agrees that aspects of the licensed materials, including the specific design and structure of individual programs, constitute trade secrets and/or copyrighted material of ImageStream. Customer agrees not to disclose, provide, or otherwise make available such trade secrets or copyrighted material in any form to any third party without the prior written consent of ImageStream. Customer agrees to implement reasonable security measures to protect such trade secrets and copyrighted material. Title to Software and documentation shall remain solely with ImageStream.

This License is effective until terminated. Customer may terminate this License at any time by destroying all copies of Software including any documentation. This License will terminate immediately without notice from ImageStream if Customer fails to comply with any provision of this License. Upon termination, Customer must destroy all copies of Software.

Software, including technical data, is subject to U.S. export control laws, including the U.S. Export Administration Act and its associated regulations, and may be subject to export or import regulations in other countries. Customer agrees to comply strictly with all such regulations and acknowledges that it has the responsibility to obtain licenses to export, re-export, or import Software.

This License shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Indiana, United States of America, as if performed wholly within the state and without giving effect to the principles of conflict of law. If any portion hereof is found to be void or



unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this License shall remain in full force and effect. This License constitutes the entire License between the parties with respect to the use of the Software.

Restricted Rights - ImageStream's software is provided to non-DOD agencies with RESTRICTED RIGHTS and its supporting documentation is provided with LIMITED RIGHTS. Use, duplication, or disclosure by the U.S. Government is subject to the restrictions as set forth in subparagraph "C" of the Commercial Computer Software - Restricted Rights clause at FAR 52.227-19. In the event the sale is to a DOD agency, the U.S. Government's rights in software, supporting documentation, and technical data are governed by the restrictions in the Technical Data Commercial Items clause at DFARS 252.227-7015 and DFARS 227.7202.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Software. ImageStream warrants that for a period of one (1) year from the date of original shipment from ImageStream or the date of purchase by the original Purchaser (from ImageStream or its Authorized Reseller or Distributor), whichever is later: (i) the media on which the Software is furnished will be free of defects in materials and workmanship under normal use; and (ii) the Software substantially conforms to its published specifications. Except for the foregoing, the Software is provided AS IS. This limited warranty extends only to Customer as the original licensee. Customer's exclusive remedy and the entire liability of ImageStream and its suppliers under this limited warranty will be, at ImageStream or its service center's option, repair or replacement; or, if neither of the foregoing is commercially reasonable, refund of the Software if reported (or, upon request, returned) to the party supplying the Software to Customer. In no event does ImageStream warrant that the Software is error free or that Customer will be able to operate the Software without problems or interruptions.

Hardware. The Products are manufactured from parts and components that are new or equivalent to new in accordance with industry standard practices. ImageStream warrants that, for one (1) year from the date of original shipment from ImageStream or the date of purchase by the original Purchaser (from ImageStream or its Authorized Reseller or Distributor), whichever is later, Products will be free from material defects in materials and workmanship, and will operate substantially in accordance with ImageStream's published documentation included with the Product which describes its functionality.

If, during the warranty period, a Product becomes defective or nonconforming, ImageStream will use its best efforts to correct the defect within a reasonable time after notification. The original sales receipt (from ImageStream or its Authorized Reseller or Distributor), showing the date of purchase of the Product, shall serve as proof of the date of purchase. This warranty extends to the original Purchaser and anyone who subsequently purchases the Product from the original Purchaser during the warranty period. The date of original shipment from ImageStream shall serve as the warranty origination date for any subsequent owner after the original Purchaser.



Loss or damage due to shipping the Products to you is covered by ImageStream. Loss or damage caused by shipping must be reported within seven (7) days of shipment in case of loss, or within (7) days of receipt of the Product in case of damage. All original packing materials must be made available for inspection by ImageStream or its representative. If a Product does not operate as warranted during the applicable warranty period, ImageStream shall, at its expense, correct any such defect by delivering to you an equivalent Product to replace the defective item. This is your exclusive remedy for any damaged or defective Product. All Products replaced will become the property of ImageStream.

THIS LIMITED HARDWARE WARRANTY COVERS NORMAL USE ONLY.
IMAGESTREAM DOES NOT WARRANT OR COVER:

- Damage during shipment other than original shipment to original purchaser;
- Damage caused by impact with other objects, dropping, falls, spilled liquids or immersion in liquids;
- Damage caused by a disaster such as fire, flood, wind, earthquake or lightning;
- Damage caused by unauthorized attachments, alterations, modifications or foreign objects;
- Damage caused by peripherals;
- Defects caused by failure to provide a suitable installation environment for the hardware system;
- Damage caused by power failure or power surges;
- Damage caused by use of the Product for purposes other than those for which it was designed;
- Damage from improper maintenance; or
- Damage caused by any other abuse, mishandling, or misapplication.

Restrictions. This warranty does not apply if the product (a) has been altered, except by ImageStream, (b) has not been installed, operated, repaired, or maintained in accordance with instructions supplied by ImageStream, (c) has been subjected to abnormal physical or electrical stress, misuse, negligence, or accident, or (d) is used in ultrahazardous activities.

OR ARISING FROM A COURSE OF DEALING, USAGE, OR TRADE PRACTICE, ARE HEREBY EXCLUDED TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY APPLICABLE LAW.

IN NO EVENT WILL IMAGESTREAM OR ITS SUPPLIERS BE LIABLE FOR ANY LOST REVENUE, PROFIT, OR DATA, OR FOR SPECIAL, INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES HOWEVER CAUSED AND REGARDLESS OF THE THEORY OF LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE THE PRODUCT EVEN IF IMAGESTREAM OR ITS SUPPLIERS HAVE BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. Submitting A Warranty Claim. The Customer shall submit a claim to ImageStream as outlined below:

- The customer must submit with the product as part of the claim a description of the Hardware defect or Software nonconformance in sufficient detail to allow ImageStream to confirm the same.
- The original product owner must obtain a Return Material Authorization ("RMA") number from ImageStream and, if requested, provide written proof of purchase of the product (such as a copy of the dated purchase invoice for the product) before the warranty service is provided.
- After an RMA number is issued, the defective product must be packaged securely in the original or other suitable shipping package to ensure that it will not be damaged in transit, and the RMA number must be prominently marked on the outside of the package. Do not include any manuals or accessories in the shipping package. ImageStream will only replace the defective portion of the Product and will not ship back any accessories.
- The Customer is responsible for all in-bound shipping charges to ImageStream. No Cash on Delivery ("COD") is allowed. Products sent COD will either be rejected by ImageStream or become the property of ImageStream. Products shall be fully insured by the Customer and shipped to ImageStream per the instructions obtained with the RMA number. ImageStream will not be held responsible for any packages that are lost in transit to ImageStream. The repaired or replaced packages will be shipped to the Customer via any common carrier selected by ImageStream, with shipping charges prepaid.
- ImageStream may reject or return any product that is not packaged and shipped in strict compliance with the foregoing requirements, or for which an RMA number is not visible from the outside of the package. Customer agrees to pay ImageStream's reasonable handling and return shipping charges for any product that is not packaged and shipped in accordance with the foregoing requirements, or that is determined by ImageStream not to be defective or non-conforming.
